The court has reviewed these invoices and finds the request for compensation and reimbursement of expenses to be reasonable. The court is satisfied with the work performed by the Trustee during this time frame. Accordingly, pursuant to the terms of the Order re Appointment of Trustee, the court hereby orders the Settlement Fund to pay the Trustee the sum of **Thirty-Six Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and Ninety-Four Cents (\$36,500.94)**. This amount represents 90 percent of the professional fees and 100 percent of all expenses incurred during the months of February 2016 through November 2016 (invoices dated March-December 2016). The court further orders the Settlement Fund to hold in trust to the credit of the Trustee the sum of **Nine Thousand Three Hundred Nine Dollars and Seventy-Eight Cents** (**\$9,309.78**), which represents 10 percent of the Trustee's professional fees for this time period.

Pursuant to the Order re Appointment of Trustee, the Trustee may petition for release of the 10 percent retainage on a quarterly basis, subject to the court's satisfaction of the Trustee's work and any objections to the Trustee's compensation requests.
