


Dear Mr. Speaker and Mr. President:

with amendments in the form of H. B. 19-136, SD1; *and was returned to*
THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

The House of Representatives accepted the Senate amendments and passed H. B. 19-136, SD1 during its Emergency Session, Third Regular Session on February 18, 2016.

THE BILL WAS FINALLY PASSED ON FEBRUARY 18, 2016.

H. B. No. 19-136, SD1

AN ACT

TO AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 19-08 TO SPECIFICALLY AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNOR TO REPROGRAM EXECUTIVE BRANCH APPROPRIATIONS TO PAY FOR THE 25% PENSION PAYMENTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Nineteenth Northern Marianas Commonwealth Legislature:

1 **Section 1. Findings and Purposes.** The Legislature finds that funding the 25%
2 pension payments for retirees is a public purpose for which the Governor can reprogram
3 funds. This Act is intended to remove any doubt regarding the Governor's authority to
4 reprogram funds for this purpose.

5 **Section 2. Amendments.**

6 (a) Section 501(b) of Public Law No. 19-08 is hereby amended to read as follows:

7 “(b) Except as provided herein, 1 CMC § 7402(a) and (b) are suspended to
8 provide the Governor with 100% reprogramming authority within the Executive
9 Branch. The Governor may reprogram funds for, among other things, the public
10 purpose of funding the 25% pension payments for retirees.

11 (b) Section 201(II)(6) and (7) of Public Law 19-08 are amended by deleting the
12 phrase ‘per court order.’”

HOUSE BILL 19-136, SD1

1 **Section 3. Severability.** If any provisions of this Act or the application of any such
2 provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent
3 jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or
4 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

5 **Section 4. Savings Clause.** This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be
6 construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes
7 repealed or under any rule, regulation, or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers
8 contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law.
9 The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying,
10 any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act
11 becomes effective.


1 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the


